### GENERAL PARADE GUIDELINES

Entries must observe all applicable rules and regulations and follow all instructions from police and parade officials or be restricted from the parade. The Parade Committee reserves the right to remove any entrant from the parade, either prior to assembly, at assembly or at any time during the parade if the entrant fails to meet Parade Rules or does not follow the standards of reasonable pubic taste.

The Parade Committee will have final authority over positioning of entries in the parade and the pace and movement of the parade in progress. Only forward movement by motorized vehicles is permitted. Parade officials assume no liability for any damage to floats, vehicles or for any injuries due to negligence of parade entrants. A spacing of 15 feet between unites will be enforced. All units are required to close the gap between unites when ordered by the parade officials.

Parents, or other responsible adults (18 or older) must be at the end of the parade route to pick up their children. The ratio of adult chaperones to children will be no less than 1:10 for ages 6-12 or 2:5 for ages 5 and under. These chaperones are included in the 75 person maximum limit per unit.

# No candy or hard materials may be thrown out from parade entries along the line of march.

Entries involving live animals must obtain special written approval from the Parade Committee. Equestrian units must provide certification of "Coggins Testing" and must wear diapers. Any entries involving live animals will be subject to review by the Parade Committee and the Greenville Humane Society.

Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any float, in any vehicle or on the person of any participant. Participants consuming alcohol prior to, or during the parade will be removed from the line-up.

All entrants must provide proper signs for their unit. Banners and signs should be neat and easily recognized. Six to eight inch lettering is recommended. Basic, simple signs show best.

# MARCHING/WALKING RULES AND REGULATIONS

All marching/walking units must be contained within an 18 to 20 foot width limit. There is a 75 person maximum, and all must advance in formation.

Walking units should be in Scottish attire, although not mandatory, and should maintain a banner or other identification. Flags, banners, and other displays are encouraged.

Float support vehicles may include flat bed trucks

and tractors. Commercial service truck, buses, passenger vans, or 18 wheel trucks will not be accepted.

Maximum width of float entries will be 8 feet. The maximum height is 14 feet. Floats without side rails that transport riders must be no higher than 24 inches from the ground.

### PARADE DISPERSEMENT

Parade will disperse at Main and Broad. Marching and cars will turn right on Broad off Main and follow traffic controllers. Floats will continue through Broad and Main intersection on Main and unload past Peace Center; then continue on.
